

# THE MELROSE ON 7TH AVENUE STREET FAIR SATURDAY and CLASSIC CAR SHOW MARCH 3, 2012

UNTIL 11:15

- 1• Vendor spaces are limited and available on a first paid/first reserved basis.
- 2• Vendor merchandise is to be handcrafted. Exceptions may be approved by the Street Fair Committee. **Mass merchandise is not allowed.**
- 3• Vendors are responsible to supply your own tents, tables, chairs and other merchandising supplies for your own booth. As a convenience SAMA can supply tables, chairs and tents for a fee (**please see application**)
- 4• Vendors are required to check-in and claim your space by 9am or your space may be forfeited. **Booth space is to be set-up by 10:30am**, to be open for business by 11am and to remain open until the event closes at 5pm. The vendor or a representative of the vendor must be present at the booth at all times for the duration of the street fair.
- 5• Vendors agree to sell only what is stated on the submitted application. **A SAMA representative may ask you to remove items not declared on the original application.**
- 6• Vendors agree to be present at the Street Fair despite weather conditions. **The m7 Street Fair is held rain or shine and refunds are not issued.**
- 7• Vendors are required to display the sign issued to you at the event check-in on the upper right hand corner of your booth space. This sign functions as the vendor's Street Fair business license and must be visible at all times.
- 8• Vendors display all merchandise at your own risk. SAMA is not responsible for damage, theft, or loss of merchandise or booth facilities. **Vendors will be responsible for double the replacement cost of any items "rented" from SAMA for the event.**
- 9• Vendors are responsible for the cleanliness of your own booth space and the surrounding area throughout and at the close of the street fair.
- 10• Vendors agree to allow the use of videos and photographs, taken during the street fair for promotional purposes.
- 11• Vendors agree to obey all pertinent codes, laws, ordinances and regulations, including but not limited to; fire, safety and parking. Canopy tents must be fire retardant.
- 12• SAMA, or it's Board as well as the event coordinators are not liable for refunds or any other liabilities for the vendor's failure to obey the rules and regulations or due to the unstable condition of the area in which the street fair is held, caused by but not limited to; weather, fire or other calamity, any act of nature, public enemy, strikes, statutes, ordinances of any legal authority or any other cause beyond SAMA's control.
- 13• SAMA, at their sole discretion, reserves the right to refuse participation to any vendor, entertainer, or other participant for any reason. SAMA reserves the right to request any vendor, entertainer, or other participant to vacate and leave the Street Fair premises due to merchandise or behavior deemed inappropriate for this family event, the sale of merchandise other than approved on your application or any other reason. **No refunds are issued in the case of stated incidences.**
- 14• **By signing the vendor application you are stating that you have read, understand and agree to these guidelines.**

- **All giveaway items must be approved by the Street Fair Committee before 2/01/2012**
- **Application deadline is 2/24/2012**
- **Vendor check-in and set up begins at 7:00am on Saturday March 3rd, 2012**
